



Sixth Form Dress Code

We expect members of the Sixth Form to maintain a high standard of dress and appearance whilst developing their own judgement and taste. Sixth Form students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to their position as senior leaders of the school community and role models for the younger pupils.

Everyday Dress Code

Sixth Form Students should wear:

- A formal blue/black/grey blazer – this must be worn at all times
- Outdoor coats must be removed and hung up whilst indoors
- Smart formal blouse/shirt of any colour
- Smart formal blue/black/grey skirt or trousers
- Smart formal dress in blue/black/grey
- Smart formal leather or imitation leather shoes of any colour
- Tie of a sensible pattern (compulsory when wearing a formal shirt)
- V-necked sweater without collar, lapels etc may be worn **under** a jacket but **not** as a top garment

Formal Dress Code

Students will be required to wear **formal dress code** on public occasions, formal assemblies and when there is a particular request to do so. **Formal dress code** is as above but a plain white shirt/blouse must be worn.
