SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS

Bury Grammar School offer a range of scholarships for students entering the Sixth Form from our Senior School. These scholarships carry a small monetary value, however their true purpose is to recognise the hard-work, academic and enrichment excellence and future potential of our students while rewarding their commitment to School and our values.



An important part of being a Sixth Form Scholar is a commitment to supporting younger pupils in the given area and representing the School in that field.

Scholarships carry with them a £200 award. This award is given directly to successful applicants upon them achieving the criteria of their scholarship offer and entering the Sixth Form.



ACADEMIC AND SUBJECT SCHOLARSHIPS

Subject Scholarships

Subject scholarships are offered in all A Level subjects.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student is intending to study the subject at A Level and has read beyond the curriculum;
- Student has studied the subject at GCSE - if offered* - and must achieve a 7/8/9 at GCSE;
- Student is committed to mentoring younger pupils and to be a Subject Prefect for that subject;
- During their time at BGS the student has demonstrated commitment to both the subject and School.

*Students who wish to apply for a scholarship in Economics, Politics or Psychology must demonstrate in their application letter that they have a genuine interest in and read widely in that subject. Students applying for these subjects would ideally achieve:

- **Politics** - 7/8/9 in History or RS
- **Psychology** - 7/8/9 in Science & one essay-based subject
- **Economics** - 7/8/9 in Mathematics & one essay-based subject.

Academic Scholarships

Academic scholarships will recognise a student's all round academic excellence and achievement.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student must achieve 7 grades all at 7-9 in their GCSEs;
- Student is committed to enhancing the scholarship scheme within the Sixth Form and promoting scholarships lower down the School.

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarships

A number of STEM scholarships are offered and are intended to promote the study of STEM subjects within the Sixth Form.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student will study at least two STEM subjects at A Level and intends to pursue a STEM-related degree;
- Student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote the study of STEM subjects and mentor younger pupils intending to follow similar paths;
- Students will act as a Subject Prefect for a STEM A Level.

Engineering Scholarships

A number of Engineering scholarships are offered and intended to promote the study of Engineering subjects within the Sixth Form.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student will study Maths and Physics at A Level and intends to pursue an Engineering-related degree;
- Student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote the studying of Engineering- based subjects and mentor younger pupils intending to follow similar paths;
- Students will act as a Subject Prefect for an Engineering A Level subject;
- Students will need to achieve grades 7, 8 and 9 in Maths and Physics at GCSE.

Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Science (MDV) Scholarships

A number of MDV scholarships will be offered and are designed to encourage and support those intending to pursue degrees in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Sciences.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student will study Biology and Chemistry and intends to pursue a degree in Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Science;
- Student will, during their time in the Sixth Form at BGS, promote MDV as a degree option and mentor younger pupils intending to follow the same path;
- Students will act as a Year 12 Subject Prefect for Biology or Chemistry;
- Students will need to achieve grades 7/8 in GCSEs.

SPORTING AND ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Sporting Scholarships

A number of Sporting scholarships will be offered to reward and further encourage sporting endeavour and achievement.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student is usually competing in their chosen sport at regional/national level;
- Student has demonstrated - and will continue to demonstrate - commitment to school sport;
- Students will act as a Sports Prefect.

Art and Performing Arts Scholarships

A number of Art and Performing Arts scholarships will be offered to reward, celebrate and further encourage creativity within the Sixth Form at BGS.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student can demonstrate excellence in their chosen discipline - Art/Music/Drama/Dance discipline at BGS;
- Student will promote their chosen discipline in the Sixth Form at BGS;
- Students will act as a Subject Prefect for a relevant A Level subject;
- The student will take a relevant Art/Performing Arts A Level in the Sixth Form.



APPLYING FOR A SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIP

Students who wish to apply for one or more scholarships should complete the application form and submit this and a letter of application to BGS main office.

Students letter of application must explain how they meet the eligibility criteria for the award/s they are applying for. It should be addressed to either Mrs Anderson or Mr Cassidy.

The Senior Leadership Team and Heads of Departments will consider applications in January with interviews usually taking place in January alongside Options Interviews. Offers will be made at the beginning of February with offer letters stipulating any conditions that must be met for the successful receipt of the award: this will include any GCSE requirements. The scholarship will be confirmed, and the award paid, upon the candidate successfully meeting the criteria of their scholarship offer and entering the Sixth Form.

Any pupil currently attending Bury Grammar Senior School can apply for a maximum of two scholarships. Students will only be considered for scholarships for which they have applied.
